A. POLICY STATEMENT

This policy provides guidance to ensure that the College's public disclosures are accurate, timely and appropriate, consistent with all state, federal and accreditation requirements and regulations.

C. SCOPE

Current and prospective Stephens College students, parents, enrolled students and the general public

D. SYSTEMS IN PLACE

The College has a number of systems in place to ensure that required information for current and prospective students is available, accurate, timely, and appropriate. The information available on the Consumer & Student Disclosure Information website is available to both current and prospective students and includes information required under the Higher Education Opportunity Act (HEOA).
