The relocation to the sunlit garden wing of Tower Hall, previously home to our Children's School multi-age classroom, will soon buzz with the creative energy of design talent and innovation.

The flexible Arena Classroom, adjacent to the bustling Stars Café, will also transform into a dynamic area for fashion drawing, making spaces, freshman sewing, and more.

In the heart of campus, Lela Raney Wood Hall's mezzanine will host a dedicated lecture room conveniently located next to the Historic Costume Collection Gallery and Archives. This proximity offers our students an invaluable opportunity to draw inspiration from timeless pieces as they learn.

The transformation of these spaces has been a collaborative endeavor, with faculty and students alike choosing every detail—from the color of the paint to the design of the workspaces. Missouri Women Work - Women in Trades at Stephens

Stephens College has a proud 191-year history of pioneering education for women. Our commitment to preparing students for meaningful careers and leadership roles in a global society is unwavering. <u>The Missouri Women Work</u> <u>- Women in Trades</u> program is one recent example of our continual evolution and innovative approach to education.

While the Missouri Women Work—Women in Trades program is open to all genders, it uniquely centers around women. It combines hands-on learning, classroom instruction, and industry connections to prepare women for careers in skilled trades such as construction, carpentry, and heavy highway construction.

Participants in this program also receive a range of wraparound support services, including childcare during training, transportation to and from the college and job sites, personal tools, work boots, protective workwear, and a weekly stipend throughout the program.

All of this is grant-funded, making it free for the student.

By providing women with the resources and support they need to succeed in traditionally male-dominated trades, we are breaking down barriers and creating new opportunities for economic empowerment.

The first cohort of construction pre-apprentices completed the program in May and the second in July. The program will run year-round, providing handson training, mentorship, and job placement assistance to empower women to enter and thrive in these fields. STARS ATHLETICS

Stephens Stars Earns NAIA Gold Champions of Character® Five-Star Award



The NAIA announced the **Champions of Character Five-Star Award** winners for the 2023-24 academic year, with Stephens College recognized as a gold-level recipient.

Institutions are measured on their commitment to the Champions of Character® program, earning points in character training, conduct in competition, academic focus, character recognition, and character promotion. Points are also awarded based on exceptional student-athlete grade point averages and minimal to no ejections during competitions throughout the academic year.

Each year, NAIA institutions and conferences demonstrate their progress in pursuing character-driven athletics. The Champions of Character Scorecard has a maximum of 100 points. Institutions can be recognized at three levels: Gold (90-100 points), Silver (75-89 points), and Bronze (60-74 points).

Stephens College achieved a perfect score of 100, placing them among the elite schools in the NAIA.

Summer Athletic Camps

The campus was buzzing this summer with **Stars Athletics Camps**. The camps are led by the Stars' coaching staff and current student-athletes. Camps were offered in all four varsity sports: basketball, softball, soccer, and volleyball.
