Program Delivery Types & Location

The Counseling program's clinical mental health counseling and school counseling specialization programs are delivered via blend of two formats. The primary program delivery format is through in-person/synchronous (i.e., in-class, face-to-face) courses, with the remaining courses delivered in a digital/synchronous (i.e., online via zoom/face-to-face at a dedicated date/time) format. All in-class/face-to-face and online/digital (synchronous) courses are delivered at/from the Stephens College main campus in Columbia, MO. During periods of inclement weather, faculty may provide courses via the online/digital format from a secure off-campus location.
